

Getting to the coronavirus testing point

If you suffer from respiratory infection symptoms, book an appointment for a coronavirus test in the omaolo.fi service. Please do not seek treatment without contacting the omaolo.fi service or the emergency helpline number 116117.

Do not be in physical contact with people outside your household until you have tested negative. Wear a mask when going to the sampling point, take care of good hand hygiene and keep a safety distance of two metres to others.

To avoid close contact, arrive at the sampling point primarily by car, bicycle or walking. It is also possible to arrive to the testing point by taxi or by car. When ordering a taxi, ask for a taxi with a protective class. Additionally, use a mask in the taxi. The use of public transport must be carefully considered and, in the case of a strong suspicion of coronavirus, it should not be used at all.

If a patient in poor health cannot get to the testing point by any means of transport, emergency help 116117 can be used to assess the possibility for a home hospital to take the coronavirus test at the patient's home. If the symptoms are life-threatening, always call 112.
